	 Identify and execute strategies and actions to promote the emergence of new socially responsible entrepreneurs, and allowing them to take informed decisions
	 Provide advisory services to the Government and lobby as required in the formulation and execution of business and industry related policies, acts and programmes
Key features	(1) Combines education, training, fellowships and exchange of experiences among young entrepreneurs
	(2) Recognizes the value of social responsibility among the entrepreneurs
	(3) Provides a platform to lobby governments for change in business practices
Strategy and approach	NYEF provides its members access to a dynamic network of peers at the national level. The organization provides young entrepreneurs with opportunities to engage in open dialogue and exchange of views to learn about different business opportunities, to discuss how to improve the environment for business and to achieve closer cooperation for the future. NYEF also seeks to continually advocate issues and concerns of the business community, especially those faced by young entrepreneurs. The forum seeks to develop a positive attitude towards enterprises and businesses by raising awareness and understanding and informing young people of the benefits of entrepreneurship.

Partners	The Forum was officially instituted by the Federation of Nepalese Chambers of Commerce & Industry in September 2003 as a National Youth Business Forum.
